



OVERVIEW

The Mat-Su Health Foundation (MSHF) is working to develop a vibrant, mixed-use Community Health Campus on land it owns surrounding Mat-Su Regional Medical Center, near Trunk Road and the Parks Highway. MSHF has contracted HDR to develop a Community Health Campus Master Plan that will help provide a long-range (50 year) vision for how the campus can best be developed to serve as a center for health and wellness in the Mat-Su.

The goal is to have meaningful community engagement in order to develop an implementable Master Plan that is representative of the community, addresses the future needs of the community, is supported by the community, and ultimately improves the health and wellness of Alaskans living in the Mat-Su Borough.



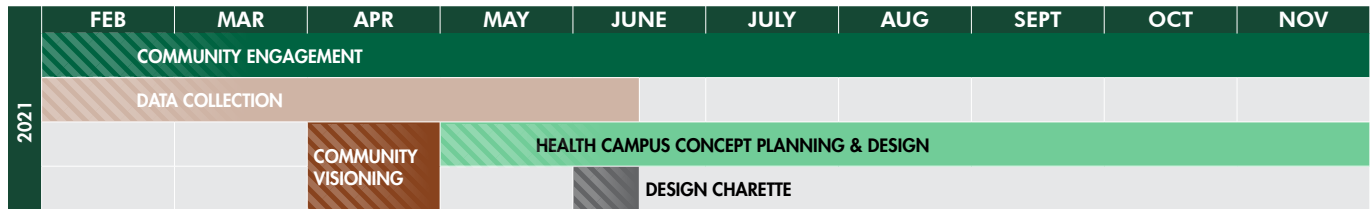
MASTER PLANNING

The MSHF has engaged HDR to create a Master Plan with a long-range (50-year) vision for the Mat-Su Community Health Campus that:

- **Develops** a vibrant center for health and wellness in the Mat-Su Borough;
- **Fosters** growth of a community health-based campus;
- **Considers** long-range hospital expansion, including mobility and parking needs, future health services, and complementary services; and
- **Understands** community value, including mixed-use development that complements the hospital and its future expansion as an open campus.

SCHEDULE AND NEXT STEPS
